





## Report on Anganwadi Visit during Community Posting on 9th January 2025



Introduction: As part of the community posting, I visited the Anganwadi Center on 9th January 2025 to assess the functioning, organization, and services provided by the center. The Anganwadi Center plays a crucial role in the health and development of children under six years of age and pregnant women. This visit was aimed at observing various aspects such as the organizational setup, worker roles, maintenance of children's records, nutritional supplements provided, and the overall functioning of the center.

- 1. ORGANIZATIONAL SETUP: The Anganwadi center is organized in a simple yet efficient manner. The center is managed by an Anganwadi Worker (AWW), supported by an Anganwadi Helper (AWH). The workers are trained to carry out the daily functions of the center, which include providing care for children, organizing nutrition programs, and educating parents on health and hygiene.
  - Head of the center: Anganwadi Worker (AWW)
  - Support staff: Anganwadi Helper (AWH)

The center operates within the premises of the local community, ensuring easy access for families in the area. The infrastructure of the center is simple, with play areas for children, a separate section for counseling, and storage spaces for the nutritional supplements.

- 2. WORKERS IN THE ANGANWADI: The main workforce in the Anganwadi center consists of the Anganwadi Worker (AWW) and the Anganwadi Helper (AWH). The AWW is responsible for overall coordination and supervision, while the AWH supports in the day-to-day activities such as feeding, hygiene, and assistance with education.
  - Anganwadi Worker (AWW): The AWW holds responsibility for the implementation of all programs and services at the center, such as child care, nutrition, immunization, health education, and maintaining records.
  - Anganwadi Helper (AWH): The AWH assists the AWW in managing children and organizing various activities, such as

- Take-home Ration: For children under 3 years and pregnant women, take-home rations (such as fortified flour, pulses, and oil) are provided to supplement their diet at home.
- Pre-school Nutrition: Midday meals are provided for children
  who attend the center for pre-school education. These meals are
  designed to meet the nutritional needs of children in their
  formative years.

The nutritional supplements are provided according to the guidelines issued by the government, ensuring the well-being of the children and mothers.

# 5. MEDICATION IN THE ANGANWADI CENTRE: The

Anganwadi center also plays a role in providing basic health care and medication. The center ensures the following:

- Basic First Aid Kit: The Anganwadi center is equipped with a first aid kit to handle minor injuries or illnesses.
- Immunization and Vitamin Supplements: The center ensures that children receive necessary vaccinations (as per the National Immunization Schedule) and vitamin supplements like Vitamin A, Iron Folic Acid (IFA) tablets, and Deworming tablets.
- **Health Education:** The Anganwadi workers educate families about common diseases, hygiene practices, and the importance of preventive health care.
- **6. RECORDS MAINTAINED:** The Anganwadi center maintains several records to ensure smooth functioning. These include:

- Attendance Registers: Both for children and for workers.
- Immunization Records: To track vaccinations provided to children.
- Growth Monitoring Charts: Recording children's weight and height at regular intervals.
- Nutritional Supplement Distribution Logs: To track the distribution of nutritional supplements and take-home rations.
- Health Records: Any illnesses, diseases, or medical interventions for the children are documented and followed up on.

These records are regularly reviewed by the Anganwadi Worker (AWW) and are shared with higher authorities during monitoring visits.

- 7. ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE: The organizational structure of the Anganwadi is part of a larger system under the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS). At the village level, the center operates with the following hierarchy:
  - Anganwadi Worker (AWW): Responsible for the day-to-day operations.
  - Anganwadi Helper (AWH): Assists the worker in various tasks.
  - Supervisor: Supervises a group of Anganwadi centers, ensuring that the services are being implemented effectively.
  - District or State Level Authorities: Oversee the functioning of the ICDS program and provide guidelines and support.

- 8. FUNCTIONS OF ANGANWADI: The Anganwadi center functions to cater to a wide range of services aimed at improving the health and well-being of children, pregnant women, and lactating mothers. The key functions include:
  - Child Care and Development: Providing early childhood education, stimulating play, and ensuring physical, cognitive, and emotional development.
  - Nutrition: Offering supplementary nutrition and take-home rations to children and women to ensure they meet their dietary requirements.
  - Health and Immunization: Conducting health check-ups, immunization sessions, and providing vitamins and other medications.
  - Growth Monitoring: Regularly measuring and recording children's growth to identify any health concerns.
  - Community Awareness: Educating parents about hygiene, health practices, and the importance of early childhood development.

CONCLUSION: The Anganwadi center plays a pivotal role in the community by providing essential services that promote the well-being of children and mothers. The center is well-organized, and the staff are dedicated to their roles. The records maintained are thorough, ensuring that each child's growth, nutrition, and health are closely monitored. The nutritional supplements and basic health services offered at the center are critical in ensuring the overall development of the children. This visit provided valuable insights into the functioning of the center and its contribution to the community.


## Report of the Event:

INTRODUCTION: As part of the General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) 1st-year curriculum, a visit to the Gram Panchayat (village council was conducted to understand the healthcare services and their role in rural settings. The visit provided a firsth and view of staffing patterns, services provided, and programs related to the medical profession.

- 1. Staffing Pattern: The Gram Panchayat has a basic healthcare unit, which is staffed by the following:
- 2. Medical Officer (MO): A doctor appointed to handle general health concerns and emergency situations. In some cases, a visiting specialist is also available.
- 3. Nurses: A trained nurse or two who assist the medical officer and handle day-to-day care. They are also responsible for maternal and child health services.
- 4. Health Workers (ANMs/ASHA): Accredited Social Health Activists (ASHA) and Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANM) are stationed at the Gram Panchayat to conduct home visits, immunizations, and basic health education. They play a crucial role in outreach and awareness in the community.
- 5. Pharmacist: A pharmacist is appointed to provide essential medicines and offer consultation regarding the proper use of drugs.

6. Support Staff: Administrative and sanitary staff to maintain the cleanliness and proper functioning of the healthcare unit.

## 2. Services Provided:

The Gram Panchayat provides several essential healthcare services, including:

- ➤ Maternal and Child Health (MCH): The health workers conduct regular antenatal and postnatal check-ups, as well as immunization programs for children under the age of 5.
- ➤ Immunization Drives: Regular immunization campaigns are organized to prevent common diseases like polio, measles, and tuberculosis among children and adults.
- ➤ Primary Healthcare: The basic health unit offers consultations for common illnesses such as fever, colds, minor injuries, and skin conditions.
- ➤ Emergency Services: Basic emergency care is provided, with the possibility of referring patients to higher-level hospitals if necessary.
- ➤ Health Awareness Programs: The Gram Panchayat organizes health education sessions to raise awareness on hygiene, nutrition, sanitation, and preventive healthcare.
- ➤ Sanitation and Cleanliness: The panchayat also takes part in cleaning drives and provides sanitation facilities to ensure the health of the community.
- ➤ Health Camps: Free health check-ups and screening for diseases like hypertension, diabetes, and anemia are conducted periodically.

## 3. Programs Related to the Medical Profession:

- ➤ National Health Mission (NHM): The Gram Panchayat is an active participant in the National Health Mission, which aims to improve healthcare access and delivery in rural areas. This includes maternal and child health services, vaccination programs, and the strengthening of rural healthcare infrastructure.
- Ayushman Bharat Scheme: This government initiative provides health insurance to economically weaker sections, offering them access to hospitalization services and free treatments.
- ➤ Health and Wellness Centres (HWC): Aimed at improving the quality of primary healthcare, these centers provide comprehensive health services, including diagnostics, treatment, and referral services.
- ➤ HIV/AIDS Awareness Program: The Panchayat also conducts awareness campaigns about the prevention of HIV/AIDS, working closely with health workers to reduce stigma and promote safe practices.
- ➤ Yoga and Fitness Programs: As part of promoting wellness, the Gram Panchayat offers yoga sessions and health camps aimed at improving physical fitness and mental health.





CONCLUSION: The visit to the Gram Panchayat highlighted the importance of primary healthcare services in rural areas. The staffing pattern ensures that basic medical services are provided, and the various programs contribute significantly to improving health outcomes in the community. The collaboration between healthcare providers and the Gram Panchayat is essential for promoting overall wellness and addressing the medical needs of the rural population.

### OBJECTIVE OF THE VISIT:

The purpose of the visit was to educate and raise awareness about the importance of hand hygiene and personal hygiene among school children. The GNM 1st-year students, under my supervision, organized a skit to demonstrate these concepts in an engaging and easy-to-understand manner.
